## New cancer screenings

Eligible members will get access to new cancer screenings, including:

- For members whose Genetic Health Screen shows that they're at higher-than-average risk of developing cancer, we will provide access to a **blood test that can help detect more than 50 types of cancer**. That's important because identifying cancer early often makes it easier to treat—and beat.†
- Colon cancer is rising in adults under 50. That's why, in early 2027, our navigation team will begin helping members access **non-invasive, at-home** screening that's an alternative to colonoscopies.‡
